Use this Sudoku Paper as a worksheet to help keep track of the possibilities when solving Sudoku puzzles:

- Copy the Sudoku puzzle to this Sudoku Paper.
- In each vacant square, cross out the numbers that are used in that row, column, and 3x3 box.
- If only one possibility remains, fill in the solution. For example, in the sixth column of the first row, 2 is the only possible solution, since all other possibilities have been eliminated.
- If only two or three possibilities remain, it is sometimes helpful to circle them, as shown in the fourth column of the fourth row.
